Trips and Visitors for March

Y3 Computing at the Camden Learning Centre - Animation Workshop



The children worked in groups of three to recreate one of the Aesop's Fables they read at school. They used stop-motion animation on the 'I Can Animate' app and then edited their short films using 'iMovie'. They turned out fantastic! - You can watch them by scanning the QR codes.



Y6 History Off the Page - 1940's Workshop - Homefront 40: Operation Pied Piper



The children experienced an understanding of what classroom life was like for evacuee children in the 1940s. They were in the character of a 1940's evacuee, taking part in lessons styled to the time period. The class also created 'official' documentation, including ID cards and ration booklets. In the afternoon they used their ration books and 'old money' to go shopping on the High Street, using their ID cards.

Y1 Science - Plant Detectives at Hampstead Heath



The children visited Hampstead Heath for a 'plant detective' workshop as part of their science unit. They explored different leaves and trees as they walked through the heath, and discussed all the things plants need to grow. To finish, the class made their own plant collages by sticking grass and leaves to a piece of paper.

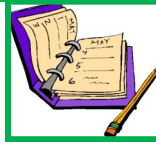

Work of the week...

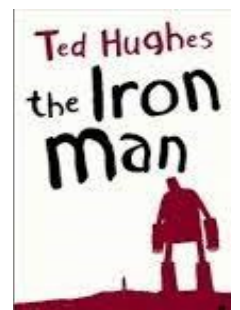
Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).

We are always really pleased to meet with you and chat things through.





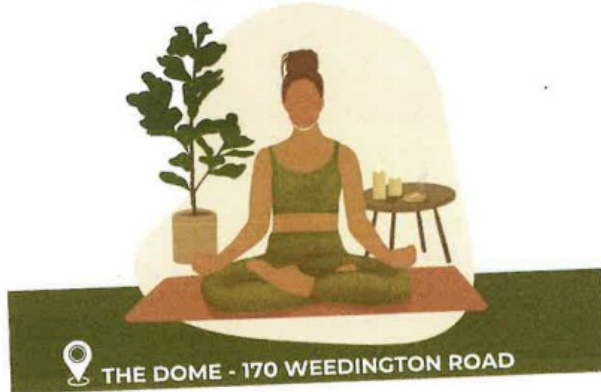

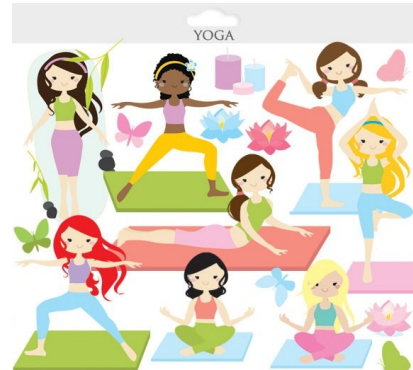
