This week the children have been learning to find minibeasts in their habitats. We used our playground to search in the soil, trees and leaves. Altogether we found a millipede, snails, worms and ants!



Gross motor skills are the skills that children develop using their whole body. By using their whole bodies children become increasingly confident, agile and flexible. Visiting your local park, riding a scooter or throwing and catching can develop these skills.



How can you help your child with their learning?

Nursery maths home learning

Barrier game

Using pasta or other loose objects arranged up to 5 objects, hide them behind a screen or an object.

Describe it to your child as “2 on the top and 2 on the bottom. How many altogether?”

As your child becomes more confident, allow them to arrange and describe it to you.
