To provide a proper balanced diet for the children.

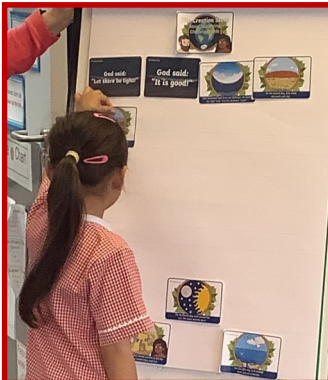
To empower the mothers of the children who attend the school.

The children have been learning that our world is a gift from God and we are called as stewards to look after it.

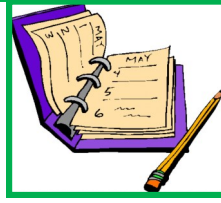
