## Science - Y2 trip to London Zoo

On Wednesday, year 2 visited London Zoo to link their prior learning to their Summer topic, which teaches them what living things need to survive. The children visited different enclosures and observed different habitats such as rainforests, woodlands and bamboo groves. In some habitats the temperature was extremely hot and humid, whereas others were cool. Year 2 saw animals that enjoy living in dark environments and others that like to live outside. Some of their favourite animals were the lemurs, monkeys, tigers and giraffes.

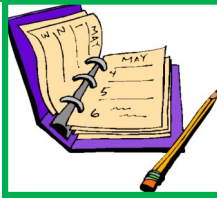

**Monday 22nd July at 2pm** - Y6 leavers assembly with Y6 parents

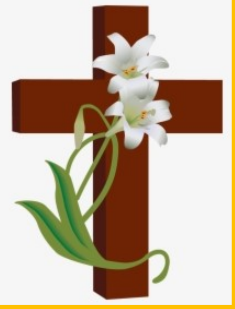
