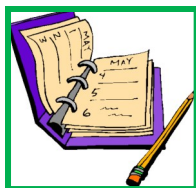

Year 6's School Journey

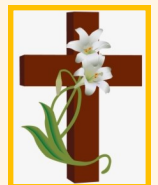
