Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).

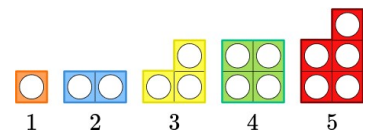


This week **Reception** have been learning to subitise four and five.
