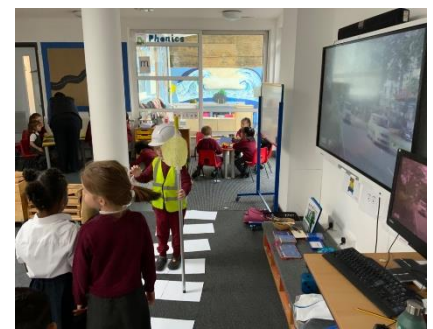


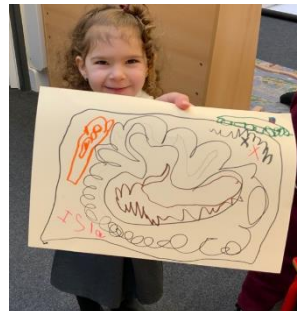
What have we been learning?

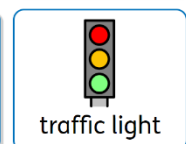
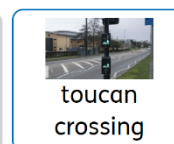
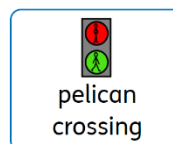
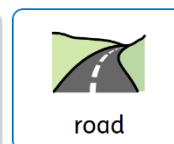
How can you help your child with their learning?
