

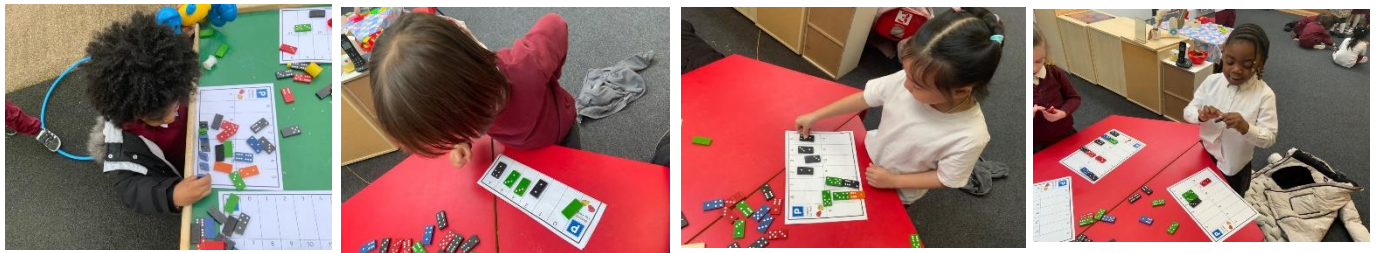
## What have we been learning?

This week we have introduced our 'Garden Centre' role-play to our outdoor area as part of our 'Growing' topic. The focus on growth provides a relevant context for the children to develop their observation and questioning skills. They explore, investigate and experiment, recognising changes over time.



In math this week, the children have been consolidating their subitising skills. Subitising is being able to visually see a number of objects instantly without needing to count them out one at a time.

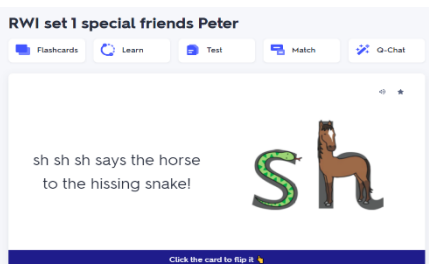


## How can you help your child with their learning?


