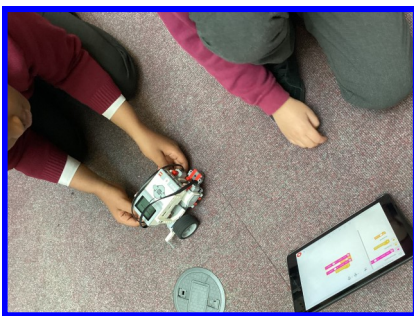
### Computing - Y2 and Y5 trips to the CLC

**Year 2** learnt how to code and create an e-book. To begin, the children used BeeBots, which they had to instruct on a floor map by inputting the number of steps forwards, as well as 90 degree turns, to get from one destination to

another. They made links to their learning about 'Looking after Our World' by programming the BeeBot to collect litter.

**Year 5** watched NASA footage of Mars Rovers landing and collecting data and used this as a stimulus to programme their own robots to follow instructions. They

had to use colour and motion sensors to ensure the rover didn't run in to any obstacles and would report back any signs of water or life.

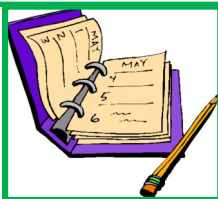
