A reminder that Academic Review Day is next Friday 13th September. On this day you have the opportunity to meet with the new class teacher, share information and find out what to expect this year.

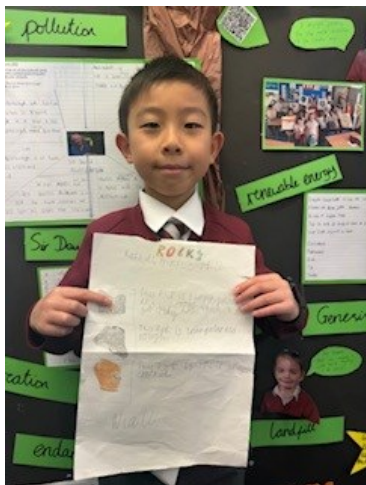
As our Year 3 teacher, Miss Robson, is back in school Monday 16th September, Year 3 will have their appointment on Friday 20th September.

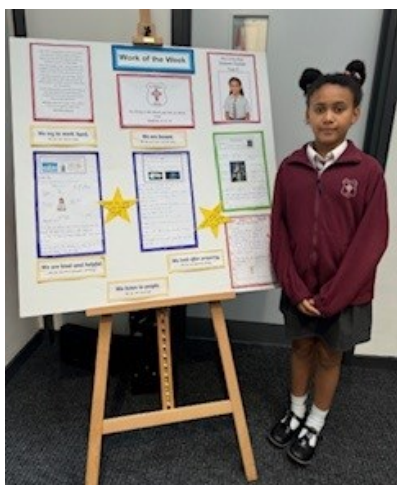
## Work of the week...
