The children took part in skateboarding, Zumba, skipping and circuit training; as well as learning about how to maintain a healthy lifestyle through exercise and healthy eating.

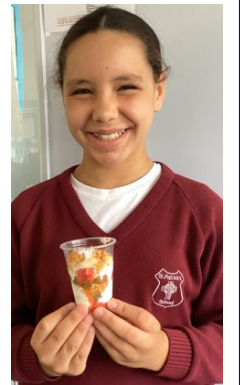

Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).

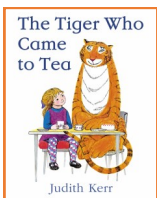
As part of Key Stage One's English curriculum, they have been reading 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr.
