Don't forget to share what you've learned with us!

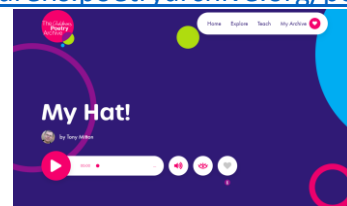
