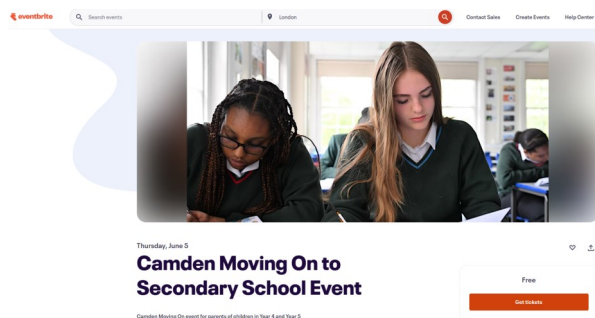
Camden 'Moving On' Secondary School Event

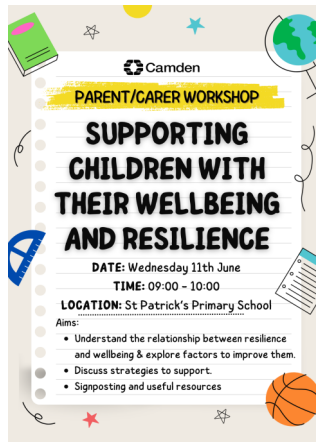
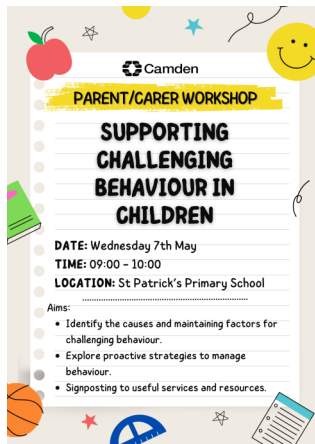
