This half term, our class is diving into the wonderful world of *minibeasts*! We've been learning what makes these tiny creatures so special — many have antennae, six legs, wings, or even hard shells, and they often live in dark, damp places. The children have enjoyed sorting animals into minibeasts and non-minibeasts, using their growing knowledge to spot the differences.



Our class story, *Snail Trail* by Ruth Brown, inspired some fantastic art as we created our own glittery snail trails using PVA glue — each with its very own snail! We'll continue exploring snails next week, observing them closely and identifying their parts.

In maths, we've been focusing on measurement, especially comparing height. Using words like *tall*, *taller*, and *tallest*, we drew around each other and had fun ordering ourselves by height!
