Inspired by what they heard and saw, the young artists created their own imaginative interpretations of the characters and prompts from the story using paint, stampers, and plenty of creativity.

-  **Create Your Own Hungry Caterpillar** – what food will your caterpillar munch through?




It was a week full of imagination, discovery, and language learning. Thanks to everyone who joined us—we can't wait to see you next time!









