

What have we been learning?

This half term, our learning is centred on *God's 7 Days of Creation*. This week, we have been reflecting on the wonderful truth that *God made me unique and created me with love*. The children enjoyed creating their own self-portraits to celebrate how special they are.

Homework:

This week, we invite families to go on a walk together in their local area. As you walk, take time to notice the beautiful features of God's creation—trees, rivers, hills, flowers, and animals. Children may make notes or sketches of what they see, ready to share their discoveries with the class. Together, we will celebrate that *"God saw that it was good"* (*Genesis 1*).



This week in Maths, we have been learning how to compare size. The children enjoyed sorting classroom objects into groups of *small*, *medium* and *big*. We also had fun building Lego towers and exploring which ones were *tall*, *taller* and *tallest*!



Phonics

This week in Phonics, we have been learning the Set 1 sounds: **u**, **b**, **f**, and **e**. The children have been practising writing these sounds, as well as reading and writing CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words using them.

Each week, you will receive your child's Sound Blending Book—please encourage them to read independently, but offer support when needed. To support them, point to each sound and then blend the sounds together quickly



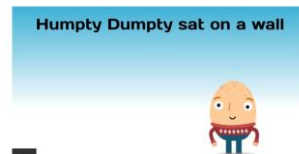

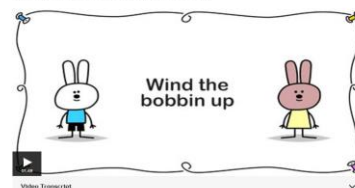
