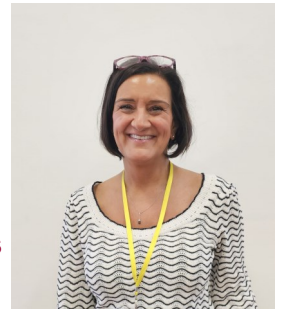

Our Prayer...

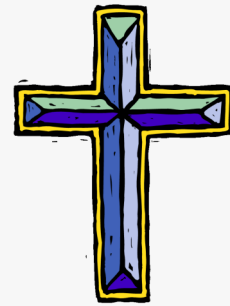
Last Sunday was the feast of All Souls
