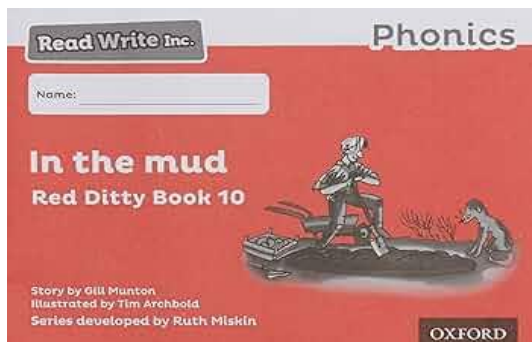
To start our Autumn 2 learning, the children have been exploring the theme of **equality**. We have been focusing on understanding that we are all different, but equally valuable, regardless of whether we are a boy or a girl. Our activities have included:

- **Exploring our community:** Learning about local buildings and the jobs people do.
- **Toys for everyone:** Sorting and playing with toys to understand that boys and girls can enjoy any toys they choose.
- **Careers for all:** Reading *Zog and the Flying Doctors* and discovering that Princess Pearl can be a doctor too. We discussed the careers we would like and role-played as different professionals.
 - **Fairness:** Talking about what is fair and unfair in everyday situations.



Reception Phonics – Red Group

This term, our reception children will begin their **'Red Group' Read Write Inc phonics books**. Each week, they will bring a book home to share and practise. In the Red Group, children start to focus on high-frequency words such as *the*, *I*, *we*, and, as well as writing simple captions to build their early writing skills.
