

## What have we been learning?

This week, we have been learning about underwater environments.

We began by sorting different environments into underwater habitats such as ponds, lakes, oceans, and coral reefs and non-underwater environments, including forests, deserts, the high street, and the park.

We then explored the features of an ocean coral reef, identifying coral, seaweed, sea sponges, pebbles, sand, and shells. Using our classroom display, the children drew their own diagrams of an underwater environment.



The children also enjoyed making the underwater environments with playdough. Adding pebbles, stones, coral reef, sea weed and sea creatures.
