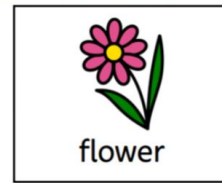
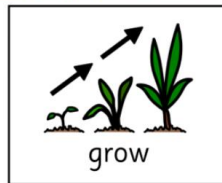


What have we been learning?

This term in EYFS we are learning about how plants grow and change. This week the children explored what it means to grow and how plants grow from seeds. We read *The Tiny Seed* by Eric Carle and discussed how seeds can travel in the wind, land in the soil, and begin to grow roots in the ground. The children enjoyed acting out the journey of the seed with actions, helping them to understand the different stages of growth. They have also had lots of fun playing and getting messy in our garden role-play area!
