Supervised Toothbrushing Programme

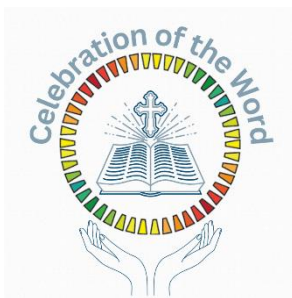

Keeping Safe Studies

As part of our Keeping Safe studies, we have been exploring road safety. The children have been learning the important motto "**Stop, Look, Listen, Think!**" and discussing how it helps us stay safe when crossing the road. We have also been reinforcing the importance of always holding an adult's hand near roads and in busy places.



We enjoyed a walk in our local area where we looked for zebra crossings and pelican crossings, and talked about how we, as pedestrians, can remember to stop, look, listen and think before crossing the road.



Throughout our sessions, the children have been developing their understanding of how to cross the road safely, taking part in road safety role play, and practising why holding hands is so important. To support their learning further, the children also enjoyed a creative activity where they carefully cut around their hand shape to reinforce the "holding hands" message.
