

What have we been learning?

This week in Maths, Reception have been learning to find and make doubles to 8. They have been exploring the idea that *double* means the same again and that a double is made of two equal parts. The children have been practising doubling numbers and recognising that, for example, double 4 makes 8.



Meanwhile, Nursery have been learning to link numerals and amounts. They have been practising showing the correct number of objects to match a given numeral, helping them build confidence in recognising numbers and understanding that numerals represent quantities.

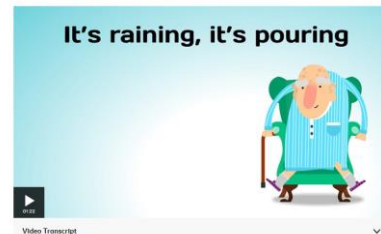

Understanding the World

This week in Understanding the World, Reception have been focusing on identifying and labelling the different parts of a plant. Using our new display, the children have been learning and using key vocabulary such as *petal*, *flower*, *stem*, *leaves*, *roots*, and *seeds or bulbs*.



Meanwhile, Nursery have been reading non-fiction texts about people who help us in the wider community. The children have enjoyed role-playing as firefighters and have been learning about the emergency number **999** and who we can call in an emergency.
