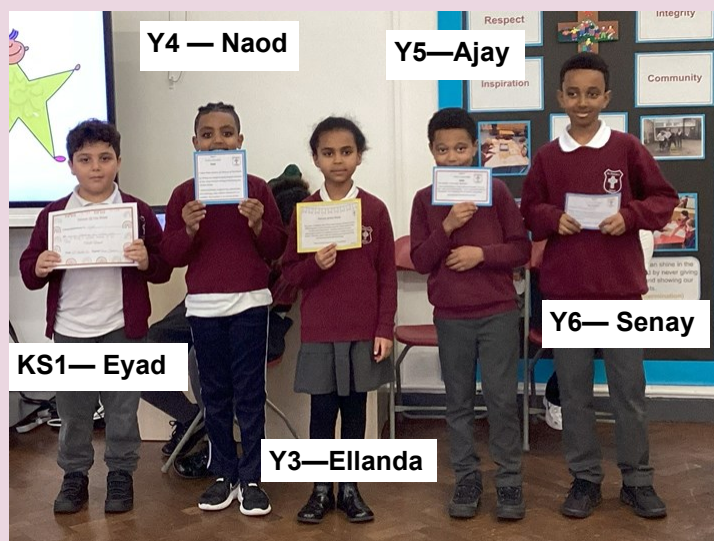
We are delighted to announce that the winners with the best attendance this week are **Year 6 with an amazing 98%**.

Work of the week...

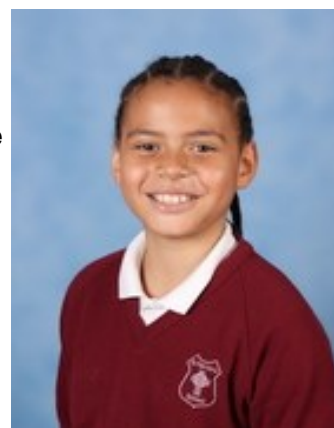
Every week a fantastic piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).
