

What have we been learning?

This week in Maths, Reception has been learning how to combine two groups of numbers and count the total. We also worked closely with our talk partners, practising how to listen carefully, describe our ideas, and speak in full sentences.



In our wider learning, we have been exploring what plants need to grow. The children have been observing our kidney beans throughout the week and noticing the changes as they develop.



In Nursery, the children have been exploring the four seasons. This is a perfect time to begin observing the environment and talking about the changes between winter and spring. You might like to encourage your child to draw a spring picture or collect signs of the changing seasons on your way home.
