Dear Parents and Carers,

Last week we reminded everyone about our agreed school uniform. Additionally this week we'd like to reiterate that, in line with Government guidance, our Governors have agreed the 3 items of uniform which need to be branded are:

1. White polo shirt **with the school logo**
2. Maroon / Burgundy sweatshirt (or cardigan) **with the school logo**
3. School book bag (Nuresery, Reception Y1, Y2 & Y3 and school back pack (Y4, Y5 & Y6) **with the school logo**.

Uniform without the school logo e.g. summer dresses, grey trousers, can be bought from any high street shop e.g. Sainsbury's, Asda, John Lewis, etc.

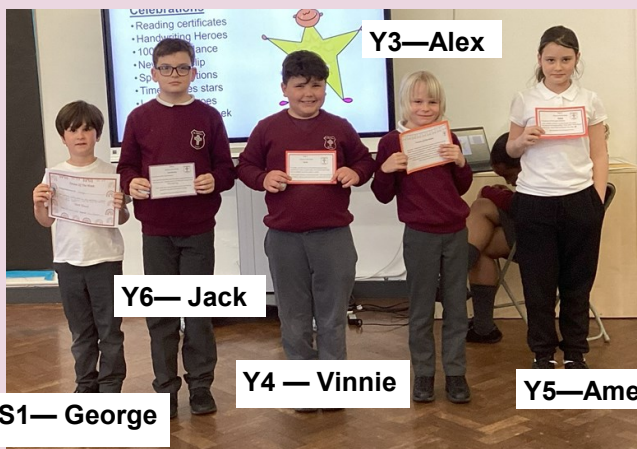
**Ariana** has written a brilliant retell using adjectives to describe each character. She has also correctly used speech marks to show when a character is talking.
