

What have we been learning? WB: 01.0.26

This week, the children have been taking part in our **Looking After Our World** studies, learning that God created our world and that we must care of it. We explored our garden to observe God's creation and discussed how we can help look after the environment. The children learnt about what happens to rubbish after it is thrown away, sequenced the rubbish cycle, explored landfill, and sorted recyclable materials to understand the importance of recycling. We also discovered how we can reuse everyday items to reduce waste by creating imaginative junk models using recyclable materials.

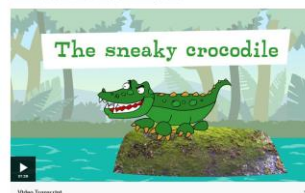

This week's Stay and Play was a great success! The children had lots of fun while developing a range of important skills through play and exploration.

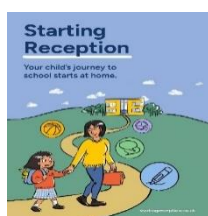
We explored **Physical Development** through ball skills, climbing, balancing, riding scooters, and moving large objects. The children also worked on **Coordination and Movement** by completing puzzles and enjoying dancing activities.

To support **Fine Motor Control**, the children used pegs, scissors, threading activities, and peg boards to strengthen their hand muscles and control. We also encouraged **Self-Help Skills**, including washing hands after using the toilet, and independently putting on and taking off coats, jumpers, and shoes.
