Zoey began by using ideas from our core text, **How Will We Get to the Beach?**, including items such as an umbrella and a ball. She then used her imagination to independently create her own list.

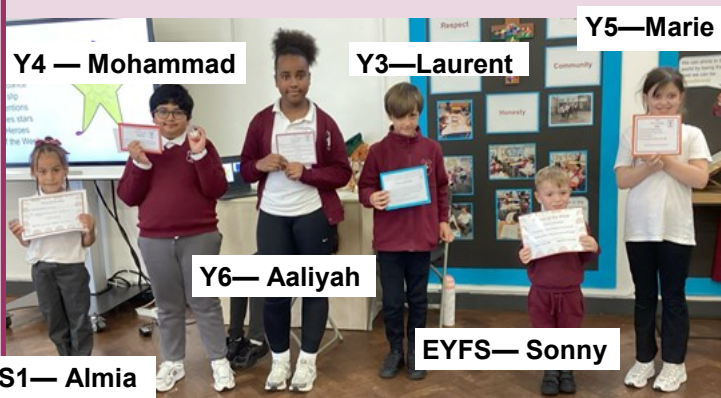
She also drew on her own experiences from trips to Portugal to help inspire her ideas and vocabulary.
