In Maths, we have been learning to create repeating patterns using our own rules. The children explored patterns with a variety of resources, including construction materials, maths counters, and puzzles. They then explained the rule for their pattern, developing their mathematical reasoning and communication skills.



The children have been developing their imaginative play in our garage role-play area, busy fixing cars with a variety of tools. They showed great creativity by making their own petrol pumps using cones and tubes, and used watering cans to carry out oil changes. It has been wonderful to see them working together, sharing ideas, and bringing their garage to life through their play.

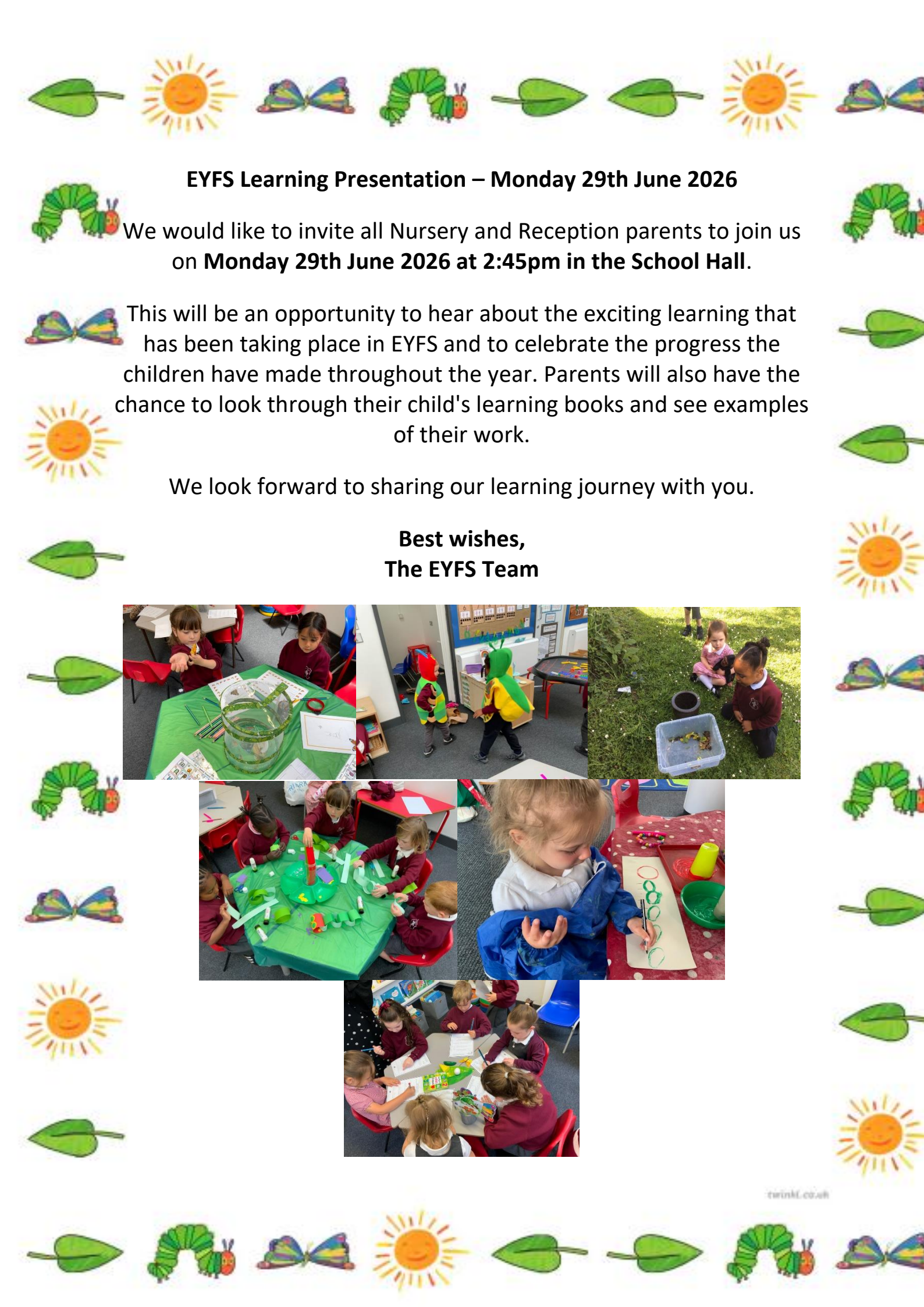
