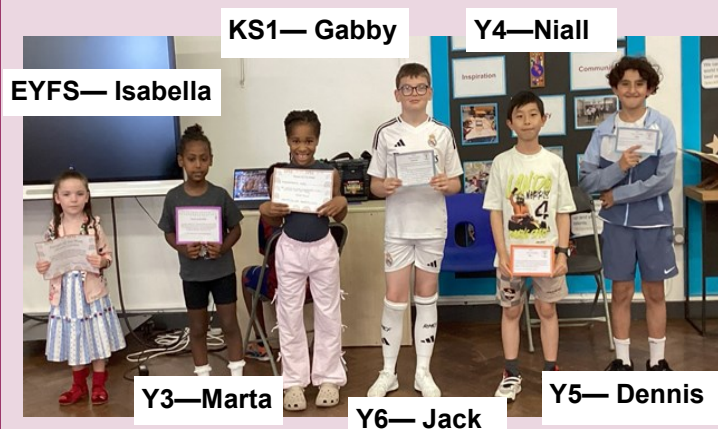


We are incredibly proud of everything Year 6 have achieved and wish them every success as they begin their exciting next chapter at secondary school.
