

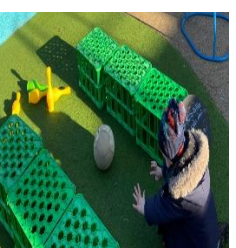
What have we been learning?

Our topic for the half term is 'under water' this week the children have been learning to name some under water environments. Such as a pond, the sea bed, the deep sea and polar regions. They worked together to sort the animals that inhabit these areas. This is in preparation for our visit to The London Aquarium!



In math, Reception has been learning to recognise 0. They enjoyed setting up their own bowling game and trying to knock down all the pins to be left with a total of 0. Nursery have been learning to recognise number patterns to 5 and recite numbers past 5.
